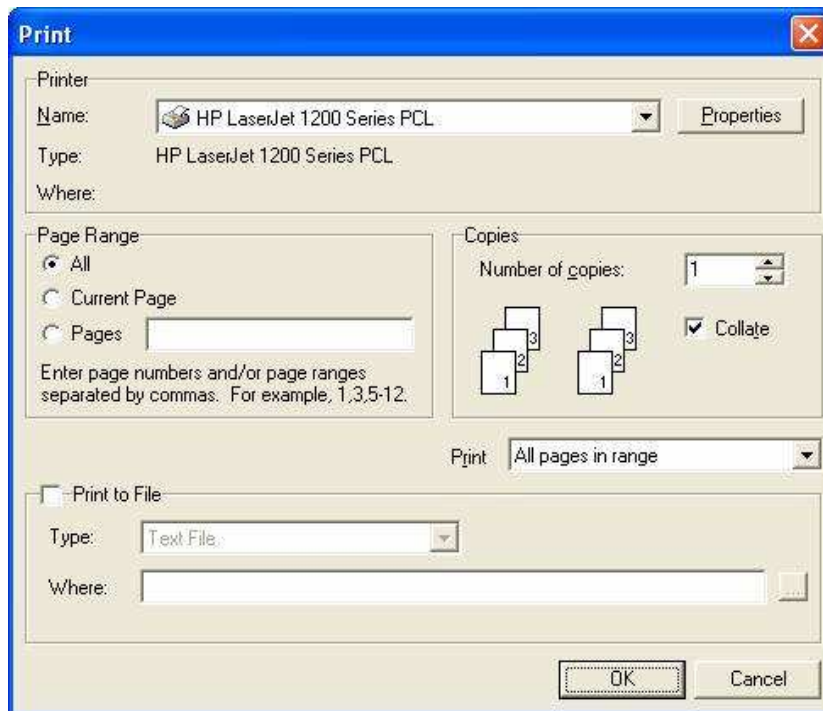
## Vetech Releases New Advantage Version

Congratulations if you have installed the latest Advantage update! You are now using the most state of the art version of Advantage for Windows®. If you have not yet loaded your update then don't delay! You will then be able to experience all of the new and exciting features. Version 25.230 includes fingerprint scanning technology, debit card support, medical record enhancements, and new report prompts during appointment check in, just to name a few. You will find more information on using these new features, as well as **MANY** others, in the release notes which accompanied the update CD.

Following the release of any new upgrade our technical support staff will field many similar calls. Here is one of the common calls we've been getting with version 25.230. "When I close an invoice and try to print it, I am now prompted every time to select my printer. Why is this happening?"

Version 25.230 has included a new Print Window when printing from the Print Preview window While the Print window has been available in other areas of the system it has been included as a standard feature on all Print Previews.

This new window gives greater flexibility for printing your reports and invoices. You now have the option of directing your output to any printer in your network on the fly. This makes it possible to save your reports and invoices as a pdf file without having to reconfigure your printers every time. You can then send your output to someone via e-mail. This window also gives you the ability to print page ranges so you no longer have to print every page of that 50 page report just to get the totals on the last page. And lastly, this window gives users the ability to save their reports as a text giving them the ability to import their results to a spreadsheet.

This menu is ONLY displayed if your printers are configured with Print Preview enabled. Disabling print preview will allow you to print with no interaction. You can enable or disable Print Preview from the Printer Setup window. Click on **File/Printer setup** and uncheck the Preview box next to the desired printer. It is common to have only reports and mailing labels set for print preview. Other items like invoices, file labels, and Rx labels are generally not set to print preview to speed up processing.
