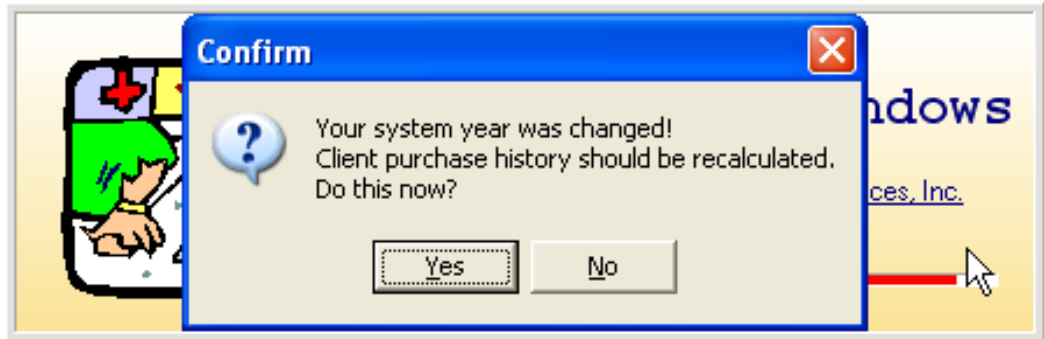

End of Year Procedures

A frequent question we are asked this time of year is “What do I need to do for the end of the year?” The simple answer is Nothing! At the end of December, you should print whatever reports you normally print on a monthly basis. If you want to get some yearly financial reports, you can do it at this time also. Of course with Advantage you can go back and print 2008 reports at any time in the future as well. Again there is nothing special that needs to be done to for Advantage to close the year.



The first time you run Advantage in 2009, you will be prompted with a message indicating that the system year has changed and you should update client YTD purchase history. You should answer yes to this question. Doing so will recalculate the YTD purchase fields on the Client + window. This should take 5-10 minutes or less for most users and you will not be prompted again – until next year. That’s it! Now you are ready to go for 2009

Windows Vista 64-bit

A new version of Windows Vista, "Windows Vista 64-bit Edition", is starting to show up on more computers, especially at retail stores. Previously this version of Windows Vista was not compatible with the version of Microsoft SQL Server that Advantage utilizes. We have now repackaged Advantage with a Microsoft SQL version that is compatible with both the 32 bit Vista Operating System, and the 64 bit Vista Operating System. If you have purchased a 64 bit Vista computer system in the past, or are considering the purchase of a 64 bit Vista computer system in the future you can now run Advantage for Veterinary with the Microsoft SQL Server on this particular operating system.

In our research we have found no real reason for users to purchase the 64 bit Vista Operating system instead of the 32 bit version in regards to running Advantage for Veterinary.
